Learning Together

Have you ever asked yourself these questions:

- How can I talk to my kids?
- How do I get my kids beyond one-word answers?
- How can I help my child set goals and follow through with them?

If you need some new tools to add to your parental “game bag” plan to attend a fun, interactive seminar called **Learning Together!**

Learning together is a day long seminar for parents, guardians and teachers that is offered on the Wednesday of the week long Residential program. Beginning at 10 am and ending at 3 pm the goal of Learning Together is to help adults learn how to help their children set and reach their goals. While your child is in class, you will meet with other adults from your school community to discuss common concerns and strategies for continuing The Leadership School message after the students return home. By the end of the day you will:

- Gain more skills to help your child set and reach their goals
- Get to know other parents and teachers in your community
- Learn about The Leadership School curriculum
- Have meals with your child and attend activities together.

Visitors Night:

From 5-7 pm on the Wednesday of the Residential program families are invited to attend dinner at The Leadership School. During this time, parents are able to tour the campus of the Leadership School, look at the cabins and meet the cabin staff and teachers that are working with the students throughout the week.
